

PIR-E SABZ



Pir-E Sabz dedicated to daughter of Yazdegerd III is also called Chak Chak.

Pir e Sabz, also called *Chak Chak*, is the green shrine dedicated to the daughter of Yazdegerd III who in an attempt to escape the Arab raiders bent on capturing her, appealed to the mountains to take her in and save her. It is said the mountains opened and she ran into the widening gap never to be seen again. The place where she disappeared, water began to flow down the mountain side. The stream of water falling steadily down the enclosed cliff face of the shrine, is said to be the tears of the royal Princess Nekbanu. People who visit the shrine say that if there are very few visiting the shrine then the water drips slowly but if there are many visitors the waters gush down as if to welcome the pilgrims. Visitors take home bottles of water filled at the Shrine for its miraculous properties.
